3 Ways You're Made for MORE

You're Made for More WORSHIP

More Worship means choosing a mindset that declares, *"Things aren't perfect, but God still is."* It's Personal, but it's also Corporate. There is power, encouragement, and faith released when God's people come together with anticipation.

You're Made for More CONNECTION

More Connection means refusing isolation. God designed us for relationships.

You need people & People need YOU.

You're Made for More SERVING

More Serving means recognizing that we were created with purpose and gifts.
